At the end of title II, insert the following:

1SEC. 212 REPORT COAST GUARD DEFENSE READINESS RE-2SOURCES ALLOCATION.

3 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Comp-4 5 troller General of the United States shall submit to the 6 Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the 7 House of Representatives and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate, a report 8 9 on the allocation of resources by the Coast Guard to support its defense readiness mission. 10

(b) CONTENTS.—The report required by subsection(a) shall include the following elements:

- (1) Funding levels allocated by the Coast Guard
 to support defense readiness missions for each of the
 past ten fiscal years.
- 16 (2) Funding levels transferred or otherwise pro17 vided by the Department of Defense to the Coast
 18 Guard in support of the Coast Guard's defense read19 iness missions for each of the past ten fiscal years.

(3) The number of Coast Guard detachments
 assigned in support of the Coast Guard's defense
 readiness mission for each of the past ten fiscal
 years.

5 (c) ASSESSMENT.—In addition to the elements de-6 tailed in subsection (b), the report shall include an assess-7 ment of the impacts on the Coast Guard's non-defense 8 mission readiness and operational capabilities due to the 9 annual levels of reimbursement provided by the Depart-10 ment of Defense to compensate the Coast Guard for its 11 expenses to fulfill its defense readiness mission.
