1	SEC STUDY AND REPORT.
2	(a) Study.—
3	(1) In general.—The Secretary of Transpor-
4	tation shall carry out a study to examine the impact
5	of inconsistent State laws or regulations, and the
6	impediments of such laws and regulations on inter-
7	state transport of oversized loads, including
8	prestressed concrete, steel beams, and other precast
9	concrete elements.
10	(2) Methodology.—In carrying out the study
11	required under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall
12	conduct a thorough review of relevant peer research
13	published in the 5 years preceding the start of the
14	study.
15	(3) Consultation.—In carrying the study re-
16	quired under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall con-
17	sult with—
18	(A) modal administrations of the Depart-
19	ment of Transportation and other other Federal

1	agencies, including the National Institute of
2	Standards and Technology;
3	(B) State departments of transportation;
4	(C) industry stakeholders; and
5	(D) appropriate academic experts.
6	(b) Report.—
7	(1) In general.—Not later than 180 days
8	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-
9	retary shall submit to Congress and publish on a
10	public website a report containing the results of the
11	study.
12	(2) Contents.—The report under paragraph
13	(1) shall include—
14	(A) a summary of inconsistent laws and
15	the impacts on construction projects, precast
16	concrete and steel fabricators, and other indus-
17	try stakeholders; and
18	(B) recommendations for State and local
19	governments on best practice methods for im-
20	proving transport of oversized loads to improve
21	safety, minimize construction delay, maximize
22	vehicle fuel economy, improve safety, and de-
23	crease costs on State and local jurisdictions.
