One behalf of the City of San Buenaventura (CA), I write in support of HR 3684, the New Vision for the Environment and Surface Transportation in America Act (INVEST in America Act).

The INVEST in America Act will allow the City to make critical investments in our transportation and water infrastructure providing long-term stability to plan, implement, monitor, and maintaining the City's drinking and wastewater systems, street network, transit system, bikeway and pedestrian facilities, and demand management programs. We are pleased that the bill authorizes \$53 billion for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund and \$40 billion for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, these funds are vital for our ability to repair, and replace aging infrastructure, secure water supply, improve water quality, and meet legal and environmental regulations.

The City is also very supportive of provisions that focus on addressing climate impacts and support climate vulnerability assessments and resiliency improvements to transportation infrastructure.

Thank you again for your leadership on these issues. We look forward to working with you and your colleagues as this bill advances through Congress.
