

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2
OFFERED BY MR. COHEN OF TENNESSEE**

Page 794, after line 10, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . DEFINITIONS AND FUNDING.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 601(a) of title 23, United
3 States Code, is amended—

4 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
5 (22) as paragraphs (2) through (23), respectively;

6 (2) by inserting before paragraph (2), as so re-
7 designated, the following:

8 “(1) ADMINISTRATIVELY ALLOCATED.—The
9 term ‘administratively allocated’ means the alloca-
10 tion by the Secretary of budget authority for a
11 project under the TIFIA program that occurs
12 when—

13 “(A) a potential applicant has been invited
14 into the creditworthiness phase for a project
15 under the TIFIA program; or

16 “(B) the project is subject to a master
17 credit agreement, in accordance with section
18 602(b)(2).”;

1 (3) in paragraph (11)(E), as so redesignated,
2 by striking “3 years” and inserting “5 years”; and
3 (4) in paragraph (13), as so redesignated—

4 (A) by striking subparagraph (E) and in-
5 serting the following:

6 “(E) a project to improve or construct
7 public infrastructure that—

8 “(i) is located within walking distance
9 of, and accessible to, a fixed guideway
10 transit facility, passenger rail station,
11 intercity bus station, or intermodal facility,
12 including a transportation, public utility,
13 or capital project described in section
14 5302(3)(G)(v) of title 49, and related in-
15 frastructure; or

16 “(ii) is a project for economic develop-
17 ment, including commercial and residential
18 development, and related infrastructure
19 and activities—

20 “(I) that incorporates private in-
21 vestment;

22 “(II) that is physically or func-
23 tionally related to a public transit or
24 passenger rail station or multimodal

1 station that includes transit or rail
2 service; and

3 “(III) for which the project spon-
4 sor has a high probability of com-
5 mencing the contracting process for
6 construction by not later than 90 days
7 after the date on which credit assist-
8 ance under the TIFLA program is
9 provided for the project;”.

10 (b) FUNDING.—Section 608(a) of title 23, United
11 States Code, is amended—

12 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (4) and (5) as
13 paragraphs (5) and (6), respectively; and

14 (2) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
15 lowing:

16 “(4) LIMITATION FOR TRANSIT-ORIENTED DE-
17 VELOPMENT PROJECTS.—For each fiscal year, the
18 Secretary may use, to carry out projects described in
19 section 601(a)(13)(E), not more than 15 percent of
20 the amounts made available to carry out the TIFLA
21 program for such fiscal year.”.
