OFFERED BY MR. DESAULNIER OF CALIFORNIA

In section 1106(b)(3), proposing to amend section 106 of title 23, United States Code, by adding at the end of such section 106 a new subsection (k) relating to megaprojects, in such proposed subsection (k), insert after paragraph (3) the following:

1 "(4) Committee.—

2	"(A) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180
3	days after the date of enactment of this sub-
4	section, the Secretary of Transportation shall
5	make appropriate arrangements with the

3	focus on the United Kingdom and France;
4	"(iii) identify recurring or typical
5	problems with megaprojects;
6	"(iv) outline possible approaches to
7	dealing with the problems in the Federal
8	and State context; and
9	"(v) recommend any changes in the
10	Department of Transportation's approach
11	to megaproject funding and oversight, such
12	as a recommendation that each project be
13	required to identify a peer group to work
14	with project management and report to the
15	Inspector General and Congress.
16	"(C) REPORT.—Not later than three years
17	after the date of enactment of this subsection,
18	the committee convened pursuant to subpara-
19	graph (A) shall submit to the Secretary, the
20	Committee on Transportation and Infrastruc-
21	ture of the House of Representatives, and the
22	Committee on Environment and Public Works
23	of the Senate a report containing any results,

findings, and recommendations made by such
committee under subparagraph (B).".

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
