Add at the end of title IV, the following:

3	(a) Requirement for Fishing Vessels To Have
4	AUTOMATIC IDENTIFICATION SYSTEMS.—Section
5	70114(a)(1) of title 46, United States Code, is amended—
6	(1) by striking ", while operating on the navi-
7	gable waters of the United States,";
8	(2) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) through
9	(D) as clauses (i) through (iv);
10	(3) by inserting before clauses (i) through (iv),
11	as redesignated by paragraph (2), the following:
12	"(A) While operating on the navigable
13	waters of the United States:"; and
14	(4) by adding at the end the following:
15	"(B) A vessel of the United States that is
16	more than 65 feet overall in length, while en-
17	gaged in fishing, fish processing, or fish ten-
18	dering operations on the navigable waters of the

1	United States or in the United States exclusive
2	economic zone.".
3	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
4	authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Com-
5	merce for fiscal year 2022, \$5,000,000, to remain avail-
5	able until expended, to purchase automatic identification
7	systems for fishing vessels, fish processing vessels, fish
8	tender vessels more than 50 feet in length, as described
9	under this title and the amendments made by this title.
