RE: Water Resources Development Act (S. 1811)

Dear Leaders Pelosi and McCarthy:

Membership of the Interstate Council on Water Policy (ICWP) includes state and interstate water resources management agencies, each who work closely with the US Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) in the efficient management of water resources in their respective states or interstate river basins. We understand that compromise language between the House and Senate is incorporated into S. 1811; we urge Congress to work together and pass this water resources development act (WRDA) in this congressional session.

ICWP stresses the importance of coordinating and communicating with states and interstate river commissions on these important water topics. ICWP members urge Congress to engage state water resource agencies during legislative development, as well as the implementation, both directly and through executive agency actions.
