

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3684  
OFFERED BY MR. LARSEN OF WASHINGTON**

Page 435, line 23, strike “urbanized”.

Page 435, line 24, strike “49,999” and insert  
“74,999”.

Page 436, line 3, strike “not included in urbanized  
areas” and insert “that are outside of an urbanized area  
with a population greater than 74,999 individuals, as de-  
termined by the Bureau of the Census”.

Page 442, after line 5, insert the following:

1 “(m) SET ASIDE.—

2 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Of the amounts made  
3 available to carry out this program, the Secretary  
4 shall set aside not less than 25 percent of such  
5 funds for projects to benefit covered cities.

6 “(2) COVERED CITY DEFINED.—In this sub-  
7 section, the term ‘covered city’ means a city, census  
8 tract, or zip code with a population of 10,000 to  
9 75,000 individuals.

10 “(n) PRIORITIZATION.—

1           “(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other  
2           provision of this section, the Secretary shall  
3           prioritize projects that will benefit covered cities pro-  
4           jected, as determined by the applicable metropolitan  
5           planning organization, to experience a significant  
6           percentage of population growth and traffic mitiga-  
7           tion growth (including measuring by housing density  
8           growth, economic impact, job creation (short term  
9           and long term), and diversity and equity for under-  
10          served communities) in a certain number of years, if  
11          the Secretary determines that there are insufficient  
12          qualified applicants to use the funds under the set  
13          asides under subsection (m).

14          “(2) COVERED CITY DEFINED.—In this sub-  
15          section, the term ‘covered city’ means a city, census  
16          tract, or zip code with a population of 10,000 to  
17          75,000 individuals.
