Page 8, line 17, strike “\$30,000,000,000” and insert “\$20,000,000,000”.

Page 28, after line 13, insert the following:

1 SEC. 7008. UPGRADING COLD STORAGE FACILITIES.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—In addition to amounts otherwise
3 available, there is appropriated to the Department of
4 Transportation and the General Services Administration
5 for fiscal year 2021, out of any money in the Treasury
6 not otherwise appropriated, \$10,000,000,000 to remain
7 available until September 30, 2025, for carrying out the
8 requirements of this section.

9 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary of Transpor-
10 tation and the Administrator of the General Services Ad-
11 ministration, in consultation with the Secretary of Health
12 and Human Services, shall—

13 (1) upgrade cold storage facilities, facilities
14 where vaccines are administered, and cold storage
15 transportation;

1 (2) prioritize creating rural vaccine storage fa-
2 cilities and rural vaccination sites;

3 (3) establish a process which provides stream-
4 lined appointment scheduling for those with limited
5 or no broadband access;

6 (4) identify processes which provide increased
7 access to scheduling vaccine appointments;

8 (5) prioritize upgrading rural broadband infra-
9 structure in order to provide future access that could
10 further the purposes of this order.

11 (c) REPORT.—The Secretary of Transportation and
12 the Administrator of the General Services Administration
13 shall—

14 (1) within 30 days, and on a quarterly basis
15 thereafter, prepare and provide an aggregated sum-
16 mary report detailing results from the efforts of the
17 requirements under subsection (a); and

18 (2) not later than 1 year after the date of en-
19 actment of this Act, submit to Congress the report
20 prepared under paragraph (1), including rec-
21 ommendations on how to improve the process of the
22 requirements under subsection (a).
