Dear Speaker Pelosi, Minority Leader McCarthy, Majority Leader Schumer, and Minority Leader McConnell:

We write to express our strong support for the passage of the Water Resources and Development Act of 2022 (WRDA). Since 2014, Congress' work to pass bipartisan, bicameral WRDA bills on a biennial basis has provided the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) with key resources and direction to meet the water infrastructure needs of communities across the nation. This year's WRDA authorizes critical investments in the Corps' studies and projects which ensure resiliency of critical infrastructure and will spur economic growth.

In particular, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) supports critical provisions in WRDA authorizing a secondary source study for the National Capital Region and borrowing authority for the Washington Aqueduct. Inclusion of these provisions will help ensure a resilient water supply for the entire Washington Metropolitan Area and provide for the maintenance and capital investments for the Washington Aqueduct.

We thank you for your continued support for water infrastructure and look forward to passage of this year's WRDA prior to the end of the year, either as a standalone bill or as part of an end-of-year legislative package.
