

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3684
OFFERED BY MR. PAPPAS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

Page 686, after line 6, insert the following:

1 SEC. 1635. REPORT ON IMPAIRED DRIVING.

2 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
3 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation, in consulta-
4 tion with the heads of appropriate Federal Agencies, State
5 highway safety offices, State toxicologists, traffic safety
6 advocates, and other interested parties, shall submit to the
7 Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation of
8 the Senate and the Committee on Transportation and In-
9 frastructure of the House of Representatives a report that
10 shall use the National Safety Council model guidelines for
11 toxicology testing and—

12 (1) identify any barriers that States encounter
13 in submitting the alcohol and drug toxicology results
14 to the Fatality Analysis Reporting System;

15 (2) provide recommendations on how to address
16 any barriers identified under paragraph (1);

17 (3) provide further steps that the Secretary,
18 acting through the Administrator of the National

1 Highway Traffic Safety Administration, will take to
2 assist States in improving—

3 (A) toxicology testing in cases of motor ve-
4 hicle crashes; and

5 (B) the reporting of alcohol and drug toxi-
6 cology results in cases of motor vehicle crashes
7 to include the type of drug(s) and quantifica-
8 tion noted in the toxicology report.
