- (1) identify any barriers that States encounter
 in submitting the alcohol and drug toxicology results
 to the Fatality Analysis Reporting System;
- 15 (2) provide recommendations on how to address16 any barriers identified under paragraph (1);
- 17 (3) provide further steps that the Secretary,18 acting through the Administrator of the National
