NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO THE COMMITTEE

OFFERED BY MR. WEBER OF TEXAS**

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 11\_\_ . PROHIBITION ON TRAINING AND EDUCATION IN**  
2 **CRITICAL RACE THEORY.**

3 (a) PROHIBITION.—No funds appropriated or other-  
4 wise made available under this Act may be obligated or  
5 expended to provide training or education based on critical  
6 race theory at the United States Coast Guard Academy.

7 (b) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.—

8 (1) PROTECTED SPEECH NOT RESTRICTED.—  
9 Nothing in this section shall be construed to restrict  
10 the protected speech of members of the United  
11 States Coast Guard or any cadet of the United  
12 States Coast Guard Academy.

13 (2) ACCESS TO MATERIALS FOR THE PURPOSE  
14 OF RESEARCH OR INDEPENDENT STUDY.—Nothing  
15 in this section shall be construed to prevent individ-  
16 uals from accessing materials that advocate critical  
17 race theory for the purpose of research or inde-  
18 pendent study.

1           (3) CONTEXTUAL EDUCATION.—Nothing in this  
2 section shall be construed to prevent the Super-  
3 intendent of the United States Coast Guard Acad-  
4 emy from assigning materials that advocate critical  
5 race theories for educational purposes in contexts  
6 that make clear that the United States Coast Guard  
7 Academy does not sponsor, approve, or endorse such  
8 theories or materials.

9           (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

10           (1) CRITICAL RACE THEORY.—The term “crit-  
11 ical race theory” means any theory that promotes  
12 one or more of the following concepts:

13                   (A) Any race is inherently superior or infe-  
14 rior to any other race.

15                   (B) The United States is a fundamentally  
16 racist country.

17                   (C) The Declaration of Independence or  
18 the Constitution of the United States are fun-  
19 damentally racist documents.

20                   (D) An individual’s moral character or  
21 worth is determined by his or her race.

22                   (E) An individual, by virtue of his or her  
23 race, is inherently racist or oppressive, whether  
24 consciously or unconsciously.

1 (F) An individual, because of his or her  
2 race, bears responsibility for the actions com-  
3 mitted by other members of his or her race.

4 (2) PROVIDE.—The term “provide” means—

5 (A) to include critical race theory or mate-  
6 rials that advocate such theories in curricula,  
7 reading lists, seminars, workshops, trainings, or  
8 other educational or professional settings in a  
9 manner that could reasonably give rise to the  
10 appearance of official sponsorship, approval, or  
11 endorsement;

12 (B) to contract with, hire, or otherwise en-  
13 gage speakers, consultants, diversity trainers,  
14 and other persons for the purpose of advocating  
15 critical race theory;

16 (C) to compel cadets of the United States  
17 Coast Guard Academy to affirm or profess be-  
18 lief in critical race theory; or

19 (D) to segregate cadets of the United  
20 States Coast Guard Academy or other individ-  
21 uals by race in any setting, including edu-  
22 cational and training sessions.
