Dear Colleague:

We are writing to invite you to testify before the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure's Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment about your priorities for a Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2020. As a reminder, WRDA legislation provides the legislative authority for water resources development projects and studies traditionally carried out by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), as well as policy direction to the Corps for implementation of its civil works missions.

This Members' Day hearing is an opportunity for all Members of the House of Representatives to highlight the Corps issues of importance to you and your constituents as we develop a new WRDA bill. Furthermore, this is an opportunity for Members to actively engage in the Committee's work on Corps' infrastructure and policy within our jurisdiction.

The hearing will take place on **Thursday, February 27, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. in 2167 Rayburn House Office Building**.
