 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Aviation Funding Sta-

5 bility Act of 2019".

SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINIS TRATION IN THE EVENT OF A LAPSE IN AP PROPRIATION.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—If, with respect to the Federal 5 Aviation Administration, an appropriation measure for a fiscal year is not enacted before the beginning of such fis-6 7 cal year or a joint resolution making continuing appropria-8 tions is not in effect, amounts in the Airport and Airway 9 Trust Fund not otherwise appropriated shall be available to the Administrator for continuing programs, projects, or 10 activities (including the costs of direct loans and loan 11 guarantees) that were conducted with amounts made 12 available for the Federal Aviation Administration, includ-13 ing for the accounts "Federal Aviation Administration— 14 Operations", "Federal Aviation Administration—Facili-15 ties and Equipment", "Federal Aviation Administration-16 Research, Engineering, and Development", and "Federal 17 Aviation Administration—Grants-in-Aid for Airports" in 18 19 the preceding fiscal year—

- 20 (1) in the corresponding appropriation Act for21 such preceding fiscal year; or
- (2) if the corresponding appropriation bill for
 such preceding fiscal year did not become law, then
 in a joint resolution making continuing appropriations for such preceding fiscal year.

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(b) RATE FOR OPERATIONS.—Appropriations and
 funds made available, and authority granted, for a pro gram, project, or activity for any fiscal year pursuant to
 this section shall be at a rate for operations not greater
 than —

6 (1) the rate for operations provided for in the
7 regular appropriation Act providing for such pro8 gram, project, or activity for the preceding fiscal
9 year; or

10 (2) in the absence of such an Act, the rate for 11 operations provided for such program, project, or ac-12 tivity pursuant to a joint resolution making con-13 tinuing appropriations for such preceding fiscal year. 14 (c) AVAILABILITY.—Appropriations and funds made 15 available, and authority granted, for any fiscal year pursuant to this section for a program, project, or activity shall 16 17 be available for the period beginning with the first day of a lapse in appropriations and ending with the date on 18 19 which the applicable regular appropriation bill for such fis-20 cal year becomes law (whether or not such law provides 21 for such program, project, or activity) or a joint resolution 22 making continuing appropriations becomes law, as the 23 case may be.

24 (d) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—An appropriation or25 funds made available, or authority granted, for a program,

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project, or activity for any fiscal year pursuant to this sec tion shall be subject to the terms and conditions imposed
 with respect to the appropriation made or funds made
 available for the preceding fiscal year, or authority grant ed for such program, project, or activity under current
 law.

7 (e) END OF FISCAL YEAR.—If this section is in effect
8 at the end of a fiscal year, funding levels shall continue
9 as provided in this section for the next fiscal year.

10 (f) EXPENDITURES AND OBLIGATIONS.—Expenditures and obligations made for a program, project, or ac-11 12 tivity for any fiscal year pursuant to this section shall be 13 charged to the applicable appropriation, fund, or authorization whenever a regular appropriation bill or a joint res-14 15 olution making continuing appropriations until the end of a fiscal year providing for such program, project, or activ-16 17 ity for such period becomes law.

18 (g) EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.—Section
19 9502(d)(1)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is
20 amended by striking the semicolon at the end and insert21 ing "or the Aviation Funding Stability Act of 2019;".

(h) TERMINATION.—This section shall not apply to
a program, project, or activity during any portion of a fiscal year if any other provision of law (other than an authorization of appropriations)—

(1) makes an appropriation, makes funds avail able, or grants authority for such program, project,
 or activity to continue for such period; or
 (2) specifically provides that no appropriation

shall be made, no funds shall be made available, or
no authority shall be granted for such program,
project, or activity to continue for such period.
