3 October 1 of the fiscal year that begins 2 years after 4 the date of enactment of this section, the Secretary, in collaboration with State departments of transpor-5 tation, metropolitan planning organizations, and re-6 7 gional council of governments, shall establish voluntary and consensus-based value capture stand-8 9 ards, policies, and best practices for State and local 10 value capture mechanisms that promote greater in-11 vestments in public transportation and affordable 12 transit-oriented development.

"(2) REPORT.—Not later than 15 months after
the date of enactment of this section, the Secretary
shall make available to the public a report cataloging
examples of State and local laws and policies that
provide for value capture and value sharing that pro-

- 1 mote greater investment in public transportation and
- 2 affordable transit-oriented development.".
