

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2
OFFERED BY MRS. MILLER OF WEST VIRGINIA**

At the appropriate place in the bill, insert the following:

1 ([to be provided]) PROJECT MANAGEMENT.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out [to be pro-
3 vided], the Secretary of Transportation shall ensure
4 that all contractors performing work on behalf of
5 Federal agencies, State agencies, local governments,
6 Indian Tribes, nonprofit organizations, and all other
7 entities involved in infrastructure projects—

8 (A) use standards made by third parties,
9 which shall be independent third-party certifi-
10 cation bodies accredited by an accreditation en-
11 tity domiciled in the United States, such as the
12 American National Standards Institute, for
13 project management, program management,
14 and portfolio management; and

15 (B) hold certifications made by third par-
16 ties, which shall be independent third-party cer-
17 tification bodies domiciled in the United States

1 for project managers, program managers, and
2 portfolio managers.

3 (2) WAIVER.—The Secretary, without delega-
4 tion, may waive the requirements under [to be pro-
5 vided]. A waiver may be granted provided congres-
6 sional notification is provided, in writing, of the Sec-
7 retary’s intention to waive the requirements and the
8 reasons supporting such a determination prior to
9 granting the waiver. The Secretary shall maintain a
10 written record of each waiver granted and the Con-
11 gressional notification made, together with sup-
12 porting documentation.

13 (3) NOTICE.—The Secretary shall provide con-
14 gressional notification under paragraph (2) to—

15 (A) the chair and ranking member of the
16 Committee on Transportation and Infrastruc-
17 ture of the House of Representatives;

18 (B) the chair and ranking member of the
19 Committee on Environment and Public Works
20 of the Senate; and

21 (C) the members of the Senate from the
22 State in which the principal place of such
23 project is located, and the member of the House
24 of Representatives from the congressional dis-

- 1 trict in which the principal place of such project
- 2 is located.
