AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. PENCE OF INDIANA

At the end of subtitle F of title I of division B of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. ____. DRY BULK WEIGHT TOLERANCE.

2 Section 127 of title 23, United States Code, is3 amended by adding at the end the following:

4 "(v) Dry Bulk Weight Tolerance.—

5 "(1) DEFINITION OF DRY BULK GOODS.—In
6 this subsection, the term 'dry bulk goods' means any
7 homogeneous unmarked nonliquid cargo being trans8 ported in a trailer specifically designed for that pur9 pose.

10 "(2) WEIGHT TOLERANCE.—Notwithstanding 11 any other provision of this section, except for the 12 maximum gross vehicle weight limitation, a commer-13 cial motor vehicle transporting dry bulk goods may 14 not exceed 110 percent of the maximum weight on 15 any axle or axle group described in subsection (a), 16 including any enforcement tolerance.".
