## AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2 OFFERED BY MR. ROUDA OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of subtitle B of title IV of division B of the bill, add the following:

1 (b) AMENDMENTS TO REGULATIONS.—Not later 2 than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the 3 Secretary shall issue a notice of proposed rulemaking to 4 amend regulations related to the interstate transportation 5 of household goods.

6 (c) CONSIDERATIONS.—In issuing the notice of pro7 posed rulemaking under subsection (b), the Secretary shall
8 consider the following recommended amendments to provi9 sions of title 49, Code of Federal Regulations:

13 (A) to the publication of the Administra14 tion titled "Ready to Move–Tips for a Success15 ful Interstate Move" (ESA 03005) on the
