



JFK All Day VMC Conditions/ SFO All Day VMC Condition until 2300 local Top 4th Pctile good weather day






JFK All Day VMC Conditions/ SF0 VMC Condition until 2200 local Top 16th Pctile good weather day

Text-based communications called DataComm is already in use in 55 control towers, and more are currently being added.




More than 466,000 flights have received ATC clearance via DataComm text, reducing taxi time and delays.





FAA implemented DataComm two years early and well under budget.
